## The Work of the Race Relations

Committee has been in brief as follows:  
We have had several interracial  
discussions at the Jones Highschool. We  
now send two representatives to every  
Interracial meeting in Winter Park. We  
conducted an Interracial Sunday program,  
which included moving pictures of the  
Negro Farmer and Negro Colleges. Some  
of our group attended the Y.W.C.A. conference  
that was held on the campus. After  
completing the painting of the dining  
room tables and chairs at Hungerford  
School for our winter project, we will  
now plan to concentrate on the Negro  
Country home. We expect to take out  
books, magazines, plants, pictures,  
records, and arrange entertainment for  
them. We have scheduled a state  
conference to meet April 26<sup>th</sup>, to discuss  
"Problems in the Post-War World". We have  
also planned an interhighschool conference  
for the first convenient Saturday in May.  
We have discussion groups approximately  
every other meeting, with pertinent  
topics chosen by the program committee.  
We have secured a place on the  
Planning Council in Orlando, so that  
we may follow up suggestions made in  
our interracial discussions constructively.  
We encourage our members to be well-  
read on subjects pertaining to the racial  
question so that they will approach any controversy  
scientifically.
