I cannot see that the "recent decision of the United States Supreme Court affecting segregation in public colleges and universities" as per your request will effect any immediate change for us. We are making no statement or announcement on the subject.

In the event that any Negro students should apply, each case would have to be dealt with as it presented itself.
